Women's History Month

Women's History Month is a celebration of women's contributions to history, culture, and society. It has been observed annually in the month of March in the United States since 1987.

We celebrate Women's History Month to remind ourselves of the accomplishments of women throughout the years to our culture and society. From science to politics, it is a chance to reflect on the trailblazing women who lead the way for change.

Throughout the years, history has seen some fiercely intelligent, powerful, and inspirational women who have been pioneers for women's rights and racial equality and have defined the worlds of Science, Mathematics, Aviation, Literature, Athletes, Doctors, Lawyers, Poets, Singers, the everyday hardworking women and of course Moms, just to name a few.

Women have changed the world for the better and of course are rule breakers. We could have only imagined having a female President with Shirley Chisholm, who was the first African American to be a candidate for a major party presidential and Secretary of State, Hillary Clinton. Geraldine Ferraro was unsuccessful in becoming the first female Vice President, but we continued to pursue and was successful in gaining our first African American and South Asian Vice President, Kamala Harris.

However, as women's our accomplishments were paved far back and beyond from Sojourner Truth, who was a famous abolitionist, Harriet Tubman, who served as a spy, nurse and scout during the Civil War, and Rosa Parks, who sparked an entire civil rights movement (Montgomery Bus Boycott).

Eleanor Roosevelt, who was an outspoken advocate for Civil and Women's rights, Elizabeth Dole, North Carolina's first female Senator, Sandra Day O'Connor, the first female justice of the Supreme Court of the United States, Madeleine Albright, the first female U.S. Secretary of State, Margaret Chase Smith, the first woman to be elected to both the U.S. Senate and House of Representatives, Nancy Pelosi, the first female Speaker of the House, Barbara Jordan, Pioneering Congresswoman.

Amelia Earhart, an Aviator and first women to fly solo across the Atlantic and Sally Ride, the first American woman in space.

Women also paved the way in sports from Billie Jean King, a leading Tennis Player, to Althea Gibson, who broke the color barrier in Tennis, which lead the way for Venus and Serena Williams, who both held the number one ranking multiple times to Jackie Joyner Kersee, who was the first woman to win two consecutive Olympic gold medals in the heptathlon, Mary Lou Retton, Gymnast first American Woman ever to win gold in the All Around event, Mia Hamm, soccer player who won two world championships and two Olympic medals. Eunice Shriver, the founder of the Special Olympics.

Yes, Women are good in Science as well, from Elizabeth Blackwell the first woman physician in the United States, Candice Pert, a noted neuroscientist who discovered the opiate receptor in the brain, Rosalyn Yalow, a nuclear physicist for her research on hormones, Gertrude Elion, worked in developing drugs to treat leukemia and Aids and Marie Curie, physicist, and scientist.

March may be Women's History Month, but we as women, celebrate each other year-round.


